SOP AUTHORITY STATEMENT:

As stated in the By-Laws in Article VIII 2. Annually, the Executive Committee, a Standing Committee, or an Ad hoc Committee shall...

- A. Prehospital – Ground Ambulance and Air Medical
 4. May provide educational opportunities for pre-hospital care providers.
- B. Hospital
 4. May provide educational opportunities for hospital care providers.
- C. System Performance Improvement:
 4. Develop and present educational programs based on the System Performance Improvement trend analysis.
- E. Emergency Preparedness:
 2. Develop and provide educational programs.

OPERATING PROCEDURE:

1. In order to improve patient care to acute /trauma patients across the age continuum the Texas J RAC will provide educational support by budgeting as funding allows for required courses/certifications.
 - 1.1 The courses approved for Prehospital
 - Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)
 - Pediatric Cardiac Life Support (PALS)
 - Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS)
 - National Registry (NREMT)
 - Basic Disaster Life Support (BDLS)
 - Advanced Disaster Life Support (ADLS)
 - Street Level Airway Management (SLAM)
 - Critical Care EMT-P (CCEMT-P)
 - National Incident Management System (NIMS) 300 &400.
 - 1.2 The courses approved for nursing personnel are:
 - Trauma Nurse Core Course (TNCC)
 - Emergency Nurse Pediatric Course (ENPC)
 - Certified Emergency Nurse (CEN)

- Advanced Disaster Life Support (ADLS)
- Certified Flight Registered Nurse (CFRN)
- Advanced Trauma Care Nurse (ATCN)
- Trauma Outcomes & Performance Improvement Course (TOPIC)
- Association for the Advancement of Automotive Medicine Injury Scoring Course (AAAM)
- National Incident Management System (NIMS) 300 &400.

1.3 Additional courses may be approved upon review by the Executive Committee.

2. In the event the registered person does not show at a course paid for by the RAC, the RAC will bill the facility/EMS entity for the registration fee. The Executive Committee will review for approval or denial submitted cases of extenuating circumstances.
